



## Other Games to play

As the night runs similar to a trivia night, there are games that can be played to keep people entertained and raise money at the same time.

### COIN TOSS:

#### **What you need:**

- Bottle of good quality alcohol
- Gold coins for change
- Electrical tape

#### **How to play:**

Tape placed on the floor like a starting line at one end of the game area. Bottle placed at opposite end of game area. People stand behind the line and throw gold coin towards bottle.

The closest coin to the bottle, without the coin hitting the bottle or the wall behind the bottle, wins.

Notes: The better the wine/spirit, the more likely people are going to play for it.

### SIT DOWN/STAND UP:

#### **How to play:**

The MC asks a series of predetermined questions. If what is said applies to you, you must sit down or stand up according to what is said. E.g. Sit down if you are wearing red. Stand up if you own a gold fish. The winner is the last person standing.

### HEADS AND TAILS:

#### **What you need:**

- Two 50 cent pieces

#### **How to play:**

Each person pays \$2 to enter the game. MC announces five seconds to choose heads or tails.

MC then flips a coin and announces the outcome. Anyone who does not have the right combination must sit down. Last person standing wins.

Notes: Adding another coin towards the end, makes it more difficult. Two coins has more outcomes: two heads, two tails, or one head and one tail

### PAPER AEROPLANES:

#### **What you need:**

One paper aeroplane from each table (paper on tables at the beginning of the night, and created throughout the night)

#### **How to play:**

Each table has one representative to 'fly' their plane. In turns, each player must stand behind the line and throw their plane. The winner is the person/table who has flown their plane the furthest.

If time allows, you can sort through the drawings, and give prizes for best/worst/most creative drawing.
